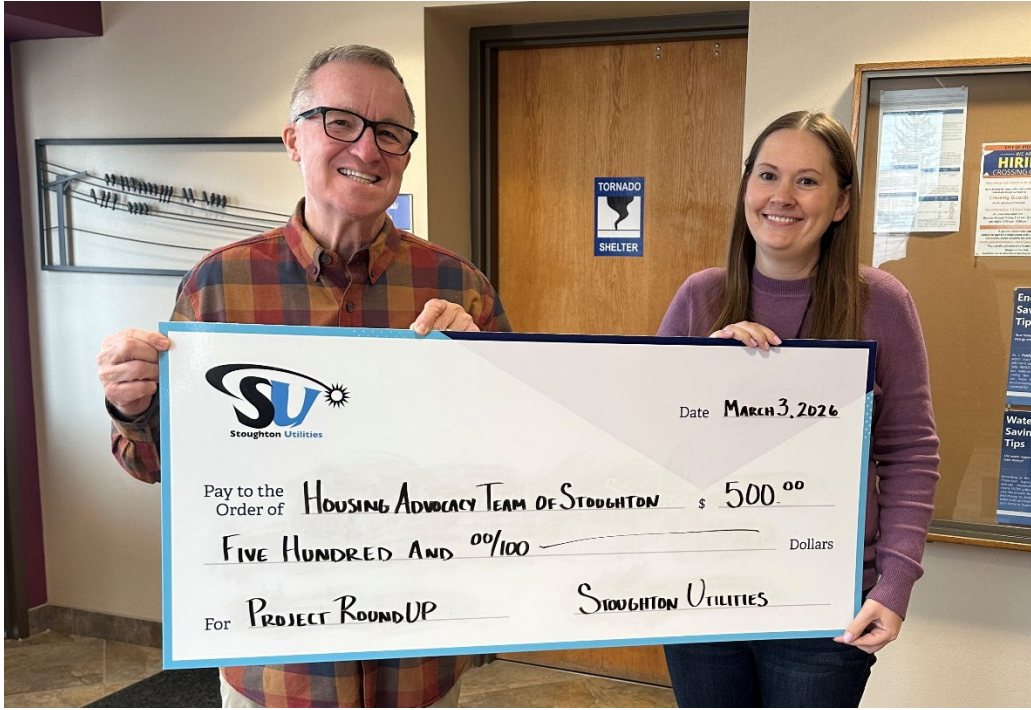
Stoughton Utilities RoundUp Program Donates \$500 to the Housing Advocacy Team of Stoughton

Stoughton Utilities recently donated \$500 to the Housing Advocacy Team of Stoughton. This donation is part of Stoughton Utilities' RoundUP program, a voluntary program that 'rounds up' customers' utility bills to the next whole dollar. All proceeds are distributed to local non-profit community organizations.

The Housing Advocacy Team of Stoughton (HATS) believes that everyone deserves stable housing and is working to eliminate homelessness in our community. According to information submitted to Project RoundUP, HATS has reduced the number of homeless children in Stoughton area schools by more than 25% over the last two years.

Stoughton Utilities began its RoundUP program in 2006 as a way to further assist local non-profit organizations in our community. Over five percent of Stoughton Utilities customers have voluntarily chosen to participate in the program and are continuing the "neighbor helping neighbor" concept that founded Stoughton Utilities over a century ago.
