Stoughton Utilities RoundUp Program Donates \$500 to Fort Littlegreen Gardens

Stoughton Utilities recently donated \$500 to Fort Littlegreen Gardens. This donation is part of Stoughton Utilities' RoundUP program, a voluntary program that 'rounds up' customers' utility bills to the next whole dollar. All proceeds are distributed to local non-profit community organizations.

Fort Littlegreen Gardens' mission is to "create an atmosphere where youth of all abilities can learn and thrive in the magic of nature in an outdoor-based camp experience." The donated funds will be used to purchase materials that will help improve the community forest food garden at Fort Littlegreen Gardens. This garden serves as an educational ecosystem, offering opportunities for children attending the camp to join with local groups in hands-on agricultural learning and activities.

Stoughton Utilities began its RoundUP program in 2006 as a way to further assist local non-profit organizations in our community. Over five percent of Stoughton Utilities customers have voluntarily chosen to participate in the program and are continuing the "neighbor helping neighbor" concept that founded Stoughton Utilities over a century ago.
